#### Who must complete this declaration?

This declaration must be completed by individuals who practise or have the training to practise the teaching profession in preschool, elementary or secondary school.

#### Steps to take:

#### Declaration

- that I have read the information sheet entitled [Practising the profession of a general education teacher](#) or [Practising the profession of a vocational education teacher](#), depending on my case, on the website of the Ministère de l'Immigration, de la Diversité et de l'Inclusion.
- that I have read the document [Terms and conditions for obtaining a Québec teaching permit - For holders of a teaching licence issued outside Canada](#)
- that I have been informed of the difficulty faced by a candidate practising the teaching profession in preschool, elementary or secondary schools in meeting the requirements for obtaining a teaching authorization from the Ministère de l'Éducation et de l'Enseignement supérieur (MEES).

Accordingly, I understand that:

- obtaining a Québec certificate of selection (CSQ) does not guarantee that I will receive authorization to teach in Québec;
- a diploma or teaching authorization obtained outside Québec does not automatically give me the right to practise my profession in Québec;
- that to practise the teaching profession in preschool, elementary or secondary schools, I must obtain a teaching authorization from the MEES, which governs the practise of my profession in Québec, and that to obtain this authorization, I am subject to requirements including:
  1. provide all the documents required to examine my file
  2. meet the academic requirements;
  3. successfully complete the compulsory French or English exam recognized by the MEES and provided under the Québec teacher training program.
  4. take compulsory supplemental training to acquire competencies related to practising the teaching profession in Québec.
  5. meet the other conditions required by the MEES, in particular, a criminal background check;
- I must contact the MEES as soon as possible if I wish to practise the teaching profession in Québec (contact information given in documents mentioned above);
- the experience I have gained through teaching **can in no case** substitute for the MEES minimum education requirements;
